Vanderbilt Museum Winter Education Workshops: Sailor's Valentine, Marine Diorama, Mummy Collar, Cat Mask

Winter School Break, February 20-25

CENTERPORT, NY (January 4, 2012) – The Suffolk County Vanderbilt Museum Education Department will offer fun, creative workshops for children before and during the February 20-25 winter school break.

The school break coincides with the observance of Presidents' Day on Monday, February 20. During that week, the Vanderbilt Museum will be open every day from Saturday, February18, through Saturday, February 18, from 11:00 to 5:00 p.m. Hours on Sunday, February 26, will be noon to 5:00 p.m. (The last mansion tour begins each day at 5:00 p.m.)

On Sunday, February 12, a **Sailor's Valentine** workshop will be offered for children in Pre-K and Kindergarten, 11:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Visit the museum's seashell collection and create a unique valentine for someone special. Cost: \$20 per child; \$16 for museum members. Children must be accompanied by one adult.

The same workshop will be offered that day from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. for children in grades 1-3. Cost: \$25 per child; \$20 for museum members.

Monday, February 20 – Castle Door Picture Frame

Tuesday, February 21 – Marine Diorama

Visit the marine museum collection and create a watercolor illustration of your favorite specimen for your diorama.

Thursday, February 23 – Mummy Collar

Learn about the museum's 3,000 year-old Egyptian mummy and create your own collar fit for a royal.

Friday, February 24 – Big Cat Mask

Come face-to-face with big cats in the Vanderbilt's Habitat Wing and create a unique piece of art.

Wednesday, February 22 – Polar Friends

Learn about the creatures that live in Earth's Arctic habitats and make your own polar puppet friends.
