To make this picture frame you will need:

Small twigs

8" Square piece of cardboard

Glue

Paint (optional)

Embellishments such as Acorn caps, small pinecones, dried leaves, or feathers (optional)

- 1. Collect small twigs from your yard
- 2. If painting twigs, let them dry completely
- 3. Glue twigs along the edge of the cardboard
- 4. Add embellishments

Get Creative with Nature

Try a shadow drawing. It makes perfect abstract art!

Place a piece of paper on the ground where there is a shadow and draw the outline. Too windy or raining? Try a shadow coming through a window.

You can fill in with paint or chalk or leave it as is.
